- Sign up for future focus groups and receive project updates

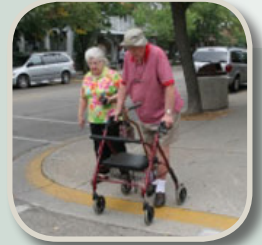
